

## 2025 Roundhouse Aquarium Summer Science Beach Camp Safety Guidelines and Camp Details

Activities may include: digging for sand crabs, playing in the waves, dissecting squid, learning about sharks, looking at plankton using a microscope, building sand sculptures, soda geyser explosions, making crafts, building a boat, doing experiments, touching live animals, playing beach games, and more!

## 2025 Guidelines:

- Small group size (approximately 12 campers and 4 counselors) that stays together all week
- Masks optional
- Drop-off and pick-up windows (we are hoping to alleviate traffic congestion by spreading out the drop-off and pick-windows):
  - o **Drop-off 8:50am-9:10am**
  - o Pick-up 11:50am-12:10pm
- Campers must bring their own water and snack each day- keep an eye out for allergy alerts on what NOT to pack
- Campers must be able to carry their own backpack/bag with supplies
- Increased sanitization, hand washing, and hand sanitizer use
- Campers **MUST** be able to use the restroom on their own, and fully potty trained.
- Campers MUST stay with their assigned group, which may be adjusted at staffs' discretion
- Please do not send your camper to camp if they are sick, especially if they test positive for COVID, the
  flu, or RSV. Your camper must be fever free and have not vomited for at least 24 hours before joining
  camp. Instead, send us an email immediately and we will work with you to make up days or obtain a
  partial refund.
- If your camper benefits from having an aide, we highly encourage you to send the aide to accompany them to camp and assist your child during camp

## **Important Information:**

- No refunds or credit without 3 business day notice for cancellation of any session
- 15% charge for all other cancellations
- \$20 charge for all session scheduling changes
- There is a \$15 charge per child for each 10 minutes a guardian is late for pick up
- CPR/First aid certified staff present at all camps
- All water activities done in front of LA county lifeguard tower
- Average 3 campers per counselor, maximum of 4 campers per counselor
- If your camper is harming other campers or is continuously disruptive, they may be required to forfeit the rest of the week and stay home
- In the event of sickness: Contact the Roundhouse staff (call or email) as soon as possible to discuss next steps in scheduling changes and/or refunding
