## What to bring each day:

## This Week's Schedule:

Each day, campers take part in sea themed activities and will win prizes for participating.

**Monday:** <u>Wacky Weather Day-</u> Rain! Snow! Lightning! Tornados! Weather happens all around us, all the time. Today campers will learn how the weather we experience every day is connected to the ocean and do wacky activities like making a tornado in a bottle! Look out, the weather can change instantly on the pier, so be ready to get wet! Campers will get their t-shirts today.

**Tuesday:** <u>Creature Connection-</u> Ever wonder how all the animals in the aquarium, from the jellyfish to the sharks, are taken care of? Well today, campers will get to meet our aquarists and learn how they care for our animals! Campers will get to meet many of the animals in person and hear the tales of how these animals survive in the ocean, as told by our animal experts. Being an aquarist is a messy job, so be prepared to get wet!

**Wednesday:** <u>Playful Plankton</u> - Today we will visit with some of the smallest and largest creatures in the sea. We'll see plankton under the microscope and find out who eats it. We'll also play a silly seaweed game and do a kelp craft.

**Thursday:** <u>Sink or Float?</u> - Today, we'll discover density by making a "magic" oil and water craft. Does an egg sink or float? What about a dollar bill? Campers will find out for themselves as we experiment on what objects sink or float.

**Friday:** Surf's Up! – Today's beach day! Be ready for a day in the sun, on the sand and in the water! Be sure to have a swim suit and towel!
